The National Dominion Club Curling Championship was held in Thunder Bay at the Fort William Curling Club the week of Nov. 18^{th} - 23^{rd} (curling week). Twenty eight of the best Canadian Club curling teams, both men's and women's took part in a superb event co-chaired by world champions Rick Lang and Heather Houston. Dan Sherrard and his Alberta rink defended the championship they won in 2012 defeating Saskatchewan's Corey Martyn in the final. The Stacey Fordyce rink from Manitoba defeated Saskatchewan's Heather Burnett in the final of the women's event.

The club deadline to enter is THURSDAY, January 16th, as the NOCA deadline for a club to declare that they will have a team is January 17th.
